To give your children an idea of what they will be doing digitally first instruct them to draw their birthday party with crayons






Make your move

The children will create a animation of their birthday party writing short lines of text in English.




Share the feeling

Collect all urls of digital birthdayparties with the names of the creators and swap it with the urls of the partnerschool. Have the children watch the party of their peers.




Is everybody invited to the party?
